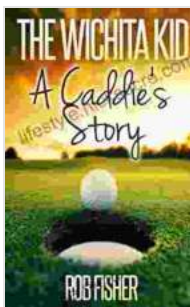


The Wichita Kid: A Caddie's Journey from Poverty to the PGA Tour

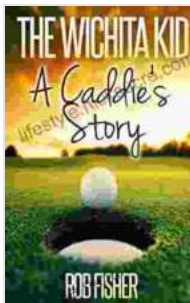

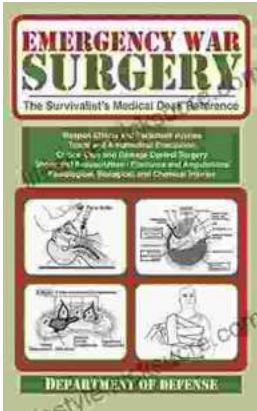
