

Roger Craig



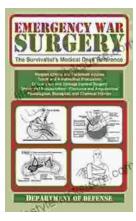
